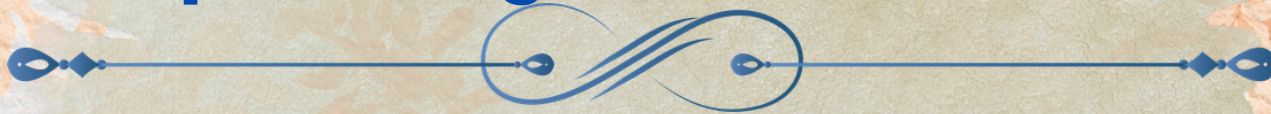


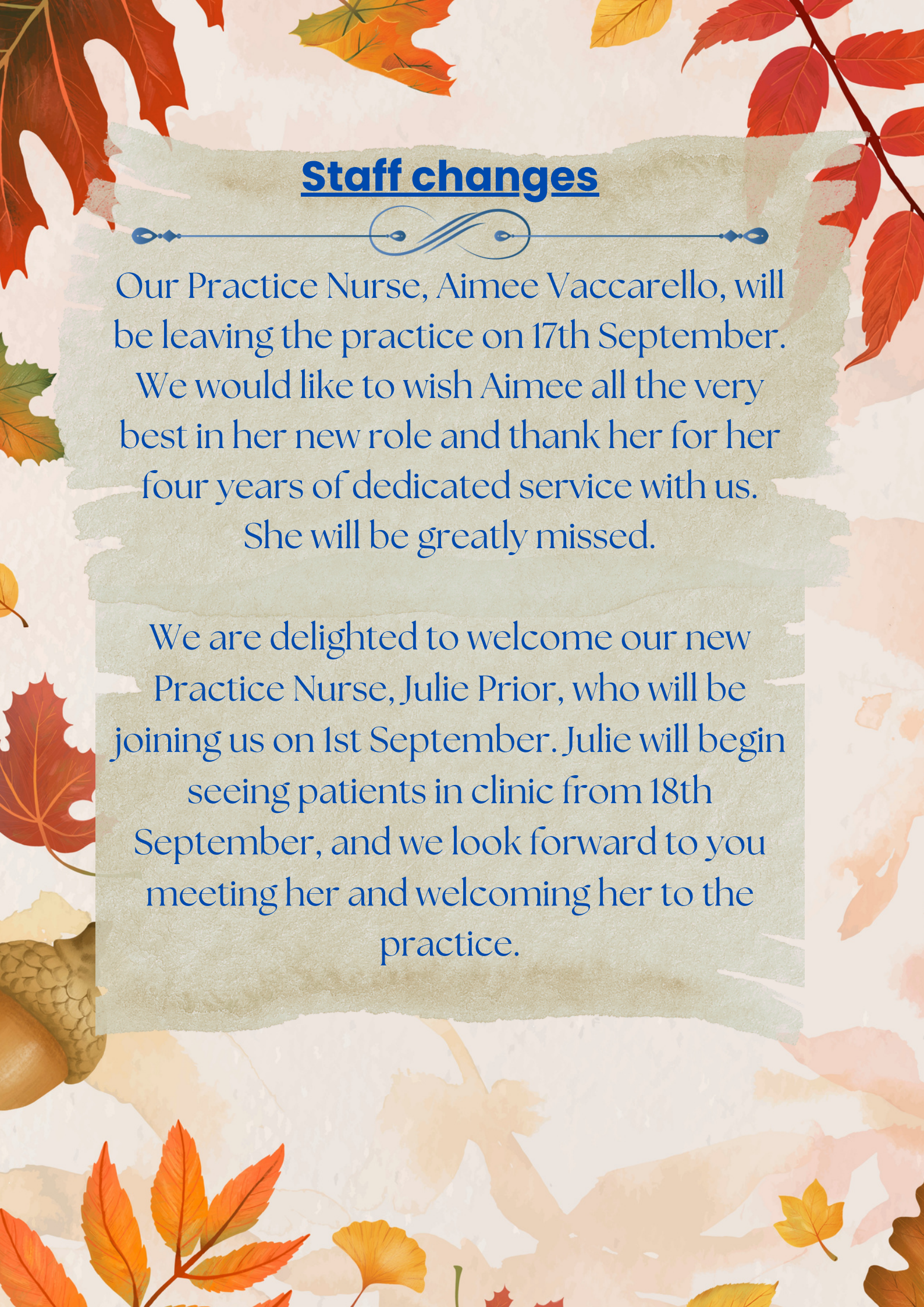
Upcoming Closure Dates:

Brighton and Hove federation are **HSJ Award finalists**

We are really pleased that ADHD Primary Care Connect has been shortlisted for Mental Health Innovation of the Year in the HSJ Awards.

As part of [Sussex Primary Care Provider Collaborative \(PCPC\)](#), we are delivering the pilot alongside Alliance for Better Care and Integrated Family Healthcare, working with Sussex Partnership NHS Foundation Trust and the ICB to provide ADHD assessment and support closer to home.

Brighton and Hove was the first area to go live, helping to shape the model as it developed. The service is now also operating across Crawley and Hastings. Since launch, the service has received **2,440 referrals** and completed **970 assessments** across the three pilot areas.

Eligible adults can access local assessment and support, with specialist oversight, named care coordination, medication support where appropriate, and links to community and wellbeing services.

A huge congratulations to everyone across the partnership who has helped develop and deliver the service. Being shortlisted is fantastic recognition of what has been achieved together, and we look forward to the HSJ Awards in November.
